8 March (Saturday)

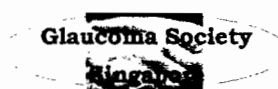
In Singapore, Glaucoma is one of the top 3 causes of blindness in adults over 40 years of age. The key to prevention of blindness is Early Detection.
